Ages 3-5 June 4th - Aug 17th

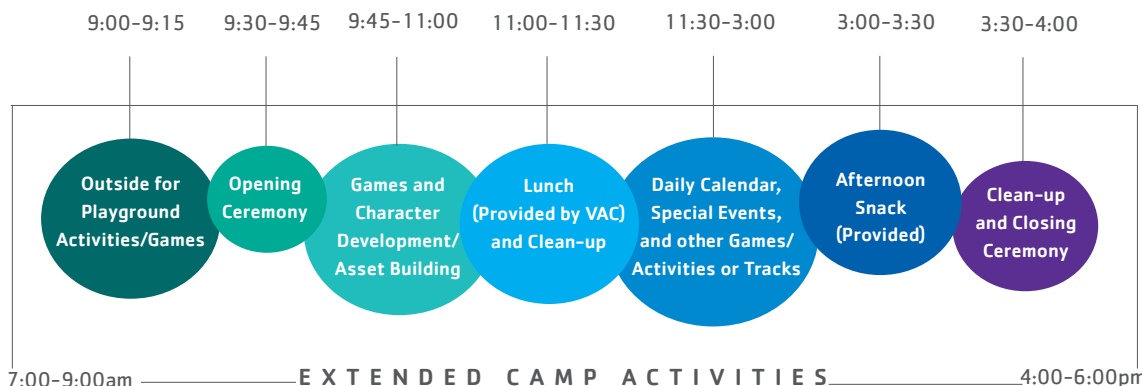

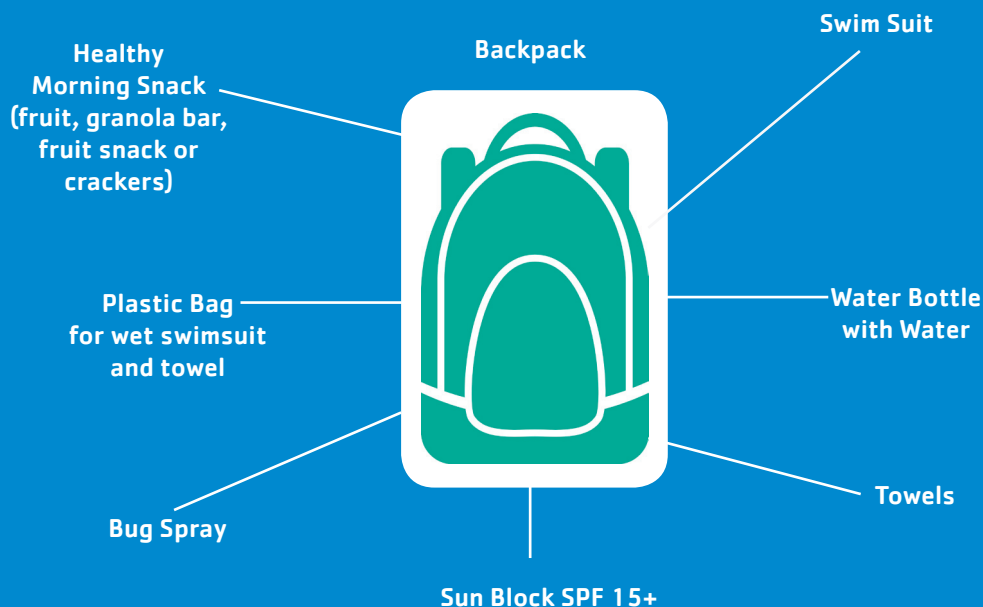
